**Q1** If the elections for Congress were being held today, which candidate would you vote for - the Republican, Robin Hayes or the Democrat, Larry Kissell? If you would vote for Robin Hayes, press 1 on your keypad now. If for Larry Kissell, press 2. If you are undecided, press 3.

*Hayes.....47% Undecided..... 8%*

*Kissell.....46%*

**Q2** Most of us are too busy to pay much attention to the news. How much attention, if any; have you paid to this week's controversy about Florida Congressman Mark Foley? If you have paid a lot of attention to the Mark Foley issue, press 1. If you paid some attention, press 2. If you haven't had time to pay attention, press 3.

*A lot of attention.....57% No attention .....10%*

*Some attention.....33%*

**Q3** Has the Mark Foley controversy in the Congress made you more likely or less likely to vote to reelect your congressman, Robin Hayes, or has the controversy made no difference to your vote. If the controversy makes you more likely to vote for Mr. Hayes, press 1. If less likely to vote for him, press 2. If no difference, press 3.

*More likely.....23% No difference .....43%*

*Less likely.....34%*

**Q4** Would you like to see the Democrats take control of Congress, or would you like to see the Republicans continue to be in control of Congress? If you want Democrats to take control, press 1. If you want Republicans to keep control, press 2. If undecided, press 3.

*Democrats .....49% Undecided..... 6%*

*Republicans .....45%*

**Q5** Do you approve or disapprove of the way President Bush is handling his job as President? If you approve, press 1. If you disapprove, press 2. If you are not sure, press 3.

*Approve.....42% Not sure ..... 7%*

*Disapprove.....51%*

**Q6** Are you more enthusiastic about voting in this election than in recent elections, or less enthusiastic? If more enthusiastic about voting, press 1. If less enthusiastic, press 2. If about the same, press 3

*More enthusiastic..62% About the same..... 18%*

*Less enthusiastic...20%*

**Q7** If you are a woman, press 1, if a man, press 2.

*Women .....54% Men.....46%*

**Q8** If you are a Democrat, press 1. A Republican, press 2. If other, press 3.

*Democrat.....44% Other.....11%*

*Republican.....44%*

**Q9** If you are white, press one now. If you are African-American, press two now. If other, press 3.

*White .....80% Other..... 5%*

*Black.....15%*

**Q10** If you are 18 to 29 years old, press 1 now. If you are 30 to 45, press 2. If you are 46 to 60, press 3. If older, press 4.

*18-29..... 6% 46-60.....38%*

*30-45.....21% Older than 60.....36%*
